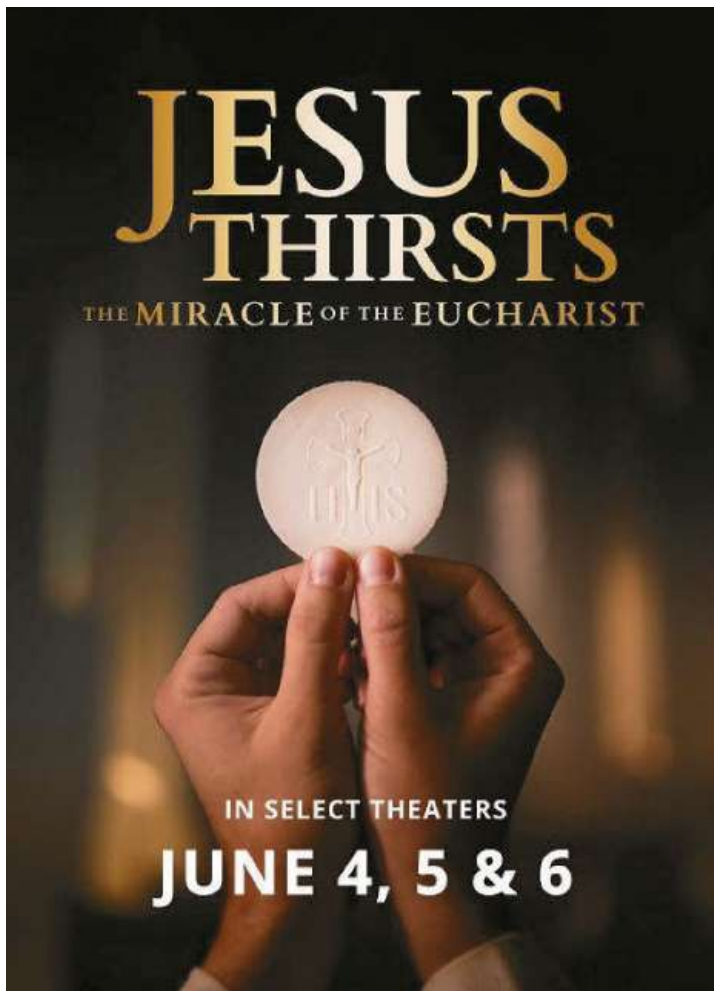

While our school year programs have finished for the year in the Office of Religious Education, we have plenty to look forward to this summer.

We invite families and godparents to bring their children and godchildren to help serve lunch for our hungry neighbors. Remember, this is not a drop off opportunity; children must have an adult with them. Sign-ups are required because our numbers are limited. How Do I Live as a Christian in the Midst of a Pagan Culture?

If you page through Paul's first letter to the Corinthians, you will see that he addresses many of the same topics that appear in the news headlines today:

scandals,
promiscuity,
debates and controversies,
and issues related to prosperity versus poverty.

Clearly, the struggles faced by the early Christians are in many ways similar to our own. Paul's messages to the Corinthians about divisions, immorality, persecution, and other trials offer much-needed wisdom for our own times.

First Corinthians: The Church and the Christian Community explores the key elements of the gospel message that Paul introduced to a new and growing Church.

Presenter Tim Gray examines Paul's advice for living an authentic Christian life in a pagan culture as well as his teachings about the nature of grace, the Church as the body of Christ, and the most powerful gift of all—the Eucharist.

This course is covered in 11 sessions, each includes a 30 minute video. Priests attend this bible study as their schedule allows. After the video, there's a question and answer opportunity.

The course is offered in person in Kavanagh Hall and is offered simultaneously via Zoom for those unable to attend in person.

Topic: Faith and Guidance

At Saint James Church we are able to scan a readily available QR Code for information about things like School Registration, Gifting, and applicable Liturgical Music. The QR Code, (Quick Response code), is described as a type of two-dimensional matrix barcode invented in 1994 by a Japanese company, originally designed to label auto parts. We're told that QR Codes connect resources with physical places or processes. Catholicism has its own resources and processes.

Q: Can a tool like a QR Code become a metaphor within the workings of faith?

A: At a recent early morning weekday Mass Father Chibuike talked about poor Lazarus and the rich man. We see, as Father pointed out, that the rich man didn't directly impose himself on the fate of Lazarus, rather there was a spirit of indifference and sinful omission of some of the essential tenets of Christianity. The love of neighbor was not present. Rich and poor themes were also there in that parable from Luke 16.

A Catholic QR Code here might have directed us to the Sermon on the Mount, or the Sermon on the Plain in Luke 6, or maybe to the parable of the Good Samaritan. A spiritual code could direct us to Pope St. John Paul II, when in 1995 he wrote about pastoral care of migrants and itinerants:

"Believers testify by their deeds that the good news is not limited to the proclamation of abstract truths, but becomes concrete in a charity that can take the form of struggling against the injustices found in the world."

Though not by a quick response, Lazarus was at last delivered and blessedly comforted by Abraham. Therein we see and believe the process of the good news, fulfilled in the poor man's heavenly reward.

The best way to understand the Eucharist is to recall God's long, careful teaching process beginning in the Old Testament.

This week in Exodus 24, we learn the basic pattern. Moses reads the dictates of God's law to the people, who profess their allegiance to it. Then Moses takes representatives of Israel's twelve tribes and splashes the sacrificed blood of animals in two directions: on the altar and on the people. It's clear and serious business: clear, because the participants are entering a blood-bond with God Himself; serious, because the dead animals symbolize the life-and-death stakes at play.

Many centuries later, God uses the experience at Sinai to teach us something new. At the Last Supper, like a new Moses, Jesus proposes to "pour out" blood as a new covenant. It will land on the altar of the cross and the lips of his disciples. They have promised to be obedient to him who is God's law in flesh. This renews and elevates the breath-taking romance God wants with His people, unfolding from Sinai to this Supper. The Body and Blood of Christ is the sacrificial action whereby this covenant is strengthened.

How hopeful that, like us, the Israelites and the apostles repeatedly fail to live up to their promises and discover that the blood of the covenant continually renews and refreshes them. Today the blood of Christ faithfully flows, to unite and renew, moving us forward toward where our great teacher is taking us. This week, we should say a renewed "amen" to God who so carefully teaches us how to be one with Him in this new covenant.

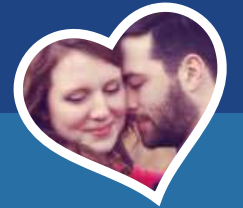

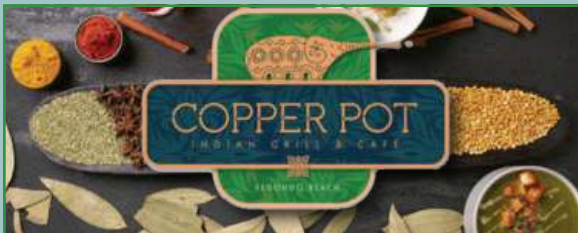

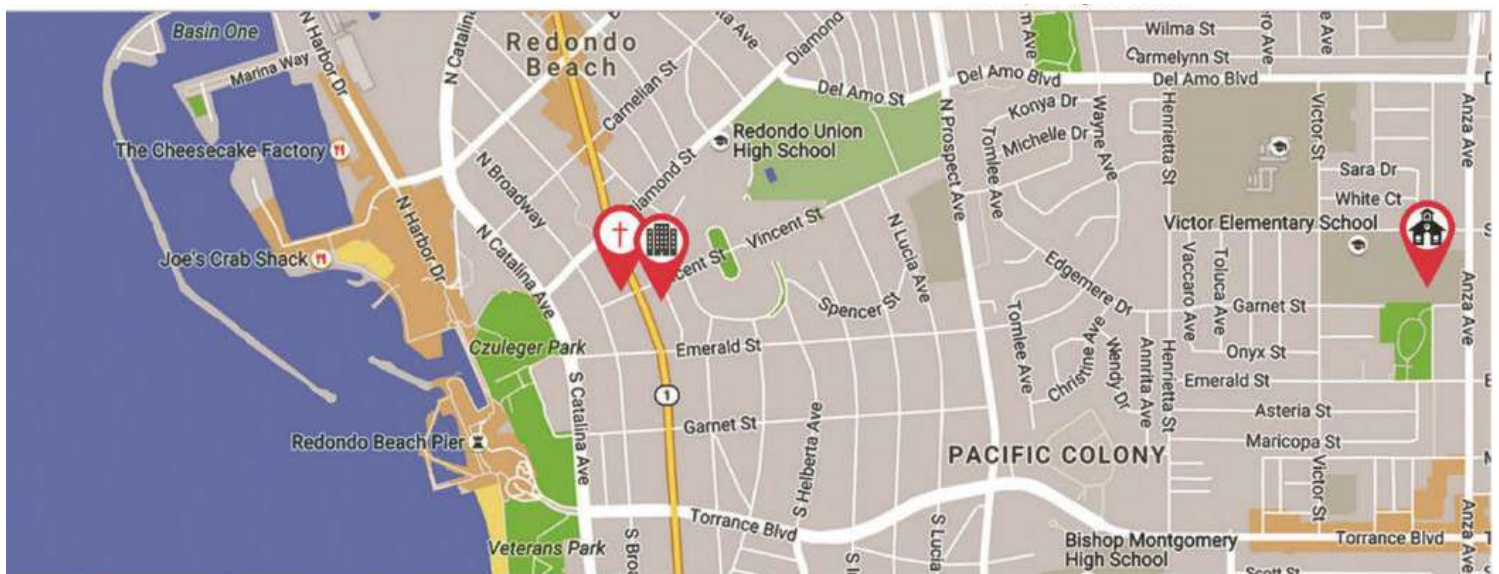
