## Imitating Jesus

*So be imitators of God as beloved children, and live in love, as Christ loved us and handed himself over for us as a sacrificial offering to God for a fragrant aroma.*

*Ephesians 5:1-2*

Have you ever heard of Wolfgang Beltracchi? For decades he created forgeries of works from the most famous painters in history and he made millions doing it. He was so talented in creating them that many of his creations were hanging and may even hang to this day, in museums and art galleries around the globe. Experts cannot even tell the difference, and this has led to an inability to verify and then appraise pieces of art all over the world. The risk for the appraiser is too high since they might get it wrong. Beltracchi claims to have made one mistake, using the wrong paint on a painting, which then led to his arrest and conviction. After serving 18 months of a 6-year jail sentence, he continues to create original art and write books in order to help pay for all the lawsuits currently against him.

There is no question about the immorality of lying and cheating in this manner. However, can you even imagine being able to create the imitation of something so close to the original that no one could tell the difference? Someone not familiar with the original could be easily fooled. But to fool so-called experts would be quite amazing.

St. Paul wrote to the Ephesians and encouraged them to be imitators of Jesus Christ., by living in love and sacrificing their very selves. Can you imagine imitating Jesus so closely that people only see Him when they look at you? The term Christian means to put on Christ. We are to be Jesus Christ to the world, leaving Mass when we have consumed him in the Eucharist so we can be more like Him. Everyday Stewards are called to give more like Christ, share more like Christ, and love more like Christ. It is no crime to imitate Jesus Christ, but instead, a sin not to try.—*Everyday Stewardship* Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS pg. 110

## How Do I Live as a Christian in the Midst of a Pagan Culture?

If you page through Paul's first letter to the Corinthians, you will see that he addresses many of the same topics that appear in the news headlines today:

scandals,  
promiscuity,  
debates and controversies,  
and issues related to prosperity versus poverty.

Clearly, the struggles faced by the early Christians are in many ways similar to our own. Paul's messages to the Corinthians about divisions, immorality, persecution, and other trials offer much-needed wisdom for our own times.

**First Corinthians: The Church and the Christian Community** explores the key elements of the gospel message that Paul introduced to a new and growing Church.

Presenter Tim Gray examines Paul's advice for living an authentic Christian life in a pagan culture as well as his teachings about the nature of grace, the Church as the body of Christ, and the most powerful gift of all—the Eucharist.

This course is covered in 11 sessions, each includes a 30 minute video. Priests attend this bible study as their schedule allows. After the video, there's a question and answer opportunity.

The course is offered in person in Kavanagh Hall and is offered simultaneously via Zoom for those unable to attend in person.

## Topic: In the Name of Jesus

**Q:** Shouldn't we appreciate particular moments when the Liturgy of the Word sort of taps the religious brakes along the regular rhythms of our faith journey, thereby prompting us to pause for moments of clarifying perspective?

**A:** Yes, and there are many such moments of reflection to appreciate. Monsignor Mike gave parishioners that thoughtful pause in a recent 10 AM Homily, evocative of the very essence of the spiritual principles of Christianity. Our Pastor invoked and emphasized some of the most heartfelt emotions of elemental Catholic beliefs:

*I love you...Forgive me...Can you forgive me?...Do you love me?...*

Similarly, this past May, Pope Francis spoke from Vatican City about the extent of the spirit of the love of Christ:

*"While it is easy for people to love what is good and beautiful...Christian love embraces what is not loveable, it offers forgiveness and blesses one's enemies."*

Within the readings this week we find ourselves in one of those moments of reflection, a sort of snapshot of a moment in time. It was along the shores of the Sea of Tiberias that morning when fishermen, disciples of Christ, were coming to shore after a night of fishing. It is here in Matthew 21 where we read and reflect once again:

*"Simon, son of John, do you love me? He replied, "Yes. Lord, you know I love you."*

*The Catechism, in equally visceral emotional fervor from Paragraph 221: "God is love and love is his first gift, containing all others."*

Will you forgive? ... Will you love?

## Gospel Meditation— Father John Muir

Jesus asks us a stunning question this week:

**“How can Satan cast out Satan?”**

To enter into this question opens up the often-hidden dynamics of what Jesus has done and is constantly doing. If we're honest, our response to some degree is:

“How *else* can we cast him out?

Satan is *precisely* how we cast out Satan!”

But Jesus wants us to see this finally does not work. Here's what I mean.

*Satanas* names the demonic mechanism by which we render wholeness through accusation. When we face a threat, we seek something to protect us (e.g., more money, social status, security, power, etc.). Rivals inevitably arise for these things and so do tensions. Accusation presents itself.

“I'll never be successful unless I get ahead of that guy.”  
“She's already trying to get ahead of me.”

“That group of immigrants is trying to take our jobs.”

And so on.

The accusation grows into a fear-inducing threat — things will break apart — no, they already are! Hurry! We inflict violence on the victim and — as if by magic — peace ensues. For a time. Soon fresh accusations are required to hold new chaos at bay, until there is no community left at all. This is essentially humankind's sad history in a nutshell.

Jesus' cross and resurrection unmasks this broken system of “casting out Satan by Satan” and ushers in a new one he calls “the Kingdom of God.” He reveals that the dynamic of accusation is nothing compared to his power of divine mercy and love. The cross (and not Satan) is the real power to tear down strongholds of sin and cast out Satan. This is why he describes himself as the **“stronger man who ties up the strong man to plunder his house.”** This week let's notice the ways we **“cast out Satan by Satan,”** and then refuse to do it anymore. Because in the long run, that divided house cannot stand.

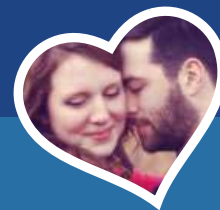

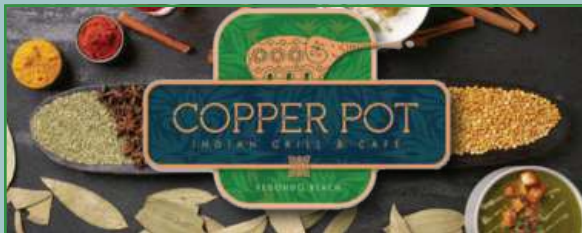

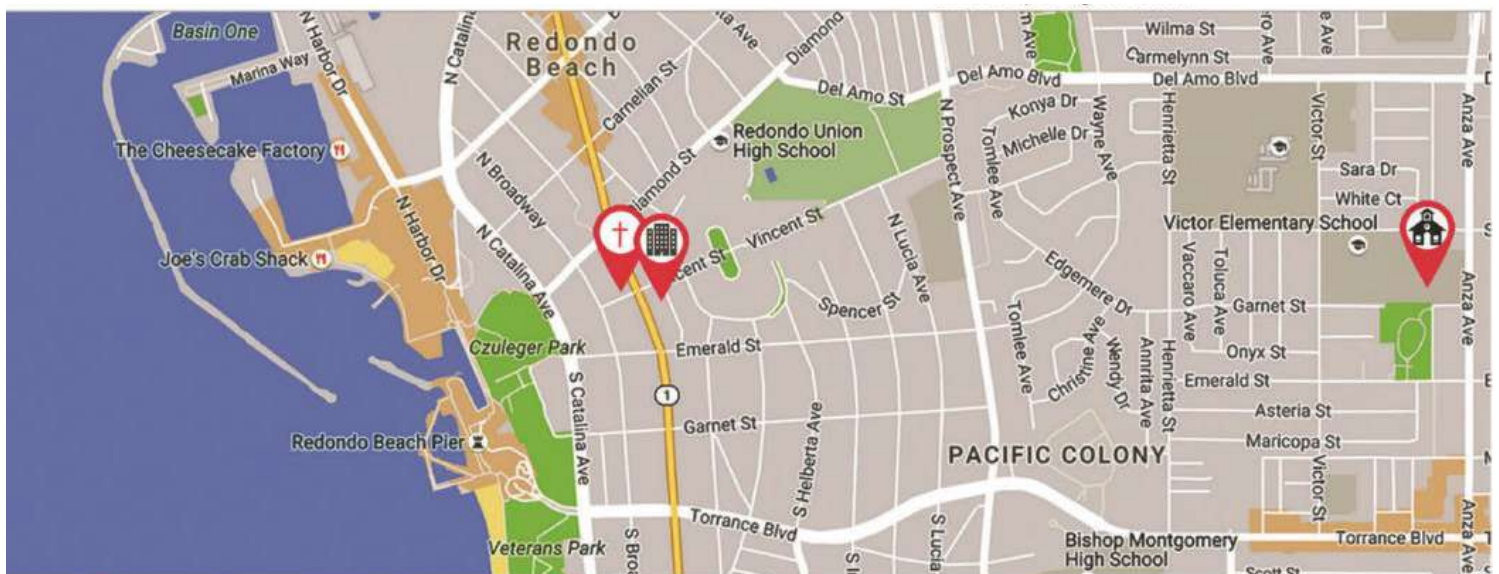
