Pastor's Letter

Our New Pastor is Fr. Matt Murphy

Please welcome our new pastor, Fr. Matt Murphy as he leads our St. James family.

Fr. Matt was born in Pennsylvania in 1965 but spent most of his life in Southern California where his home parishes were St. Didacus, Sylmar and St. Kateri Tekakwitha, Santa Clarita.

His first career was in the grocery industry working for almost 30 years for companies such as Safeway Stores, Weber's Bread, and Snapple Beverage Company.



While in his mid-30s God caught his attention and he returned to the Catholic Church after a 20-year absence. A year later, Fr. Matt was serving his parish as a youth minister, and a brief time later he began to discern a call to the priesthood.

He entered St. John Seminary, Camarillo, in September 2009 and was ordained a priest on June 4, 2016.

Following an initial 2-year assignment at St. Monica's, Santa Monica, Fr. Matt was sent to Malibu to Our Lady of Malibu Church as Administrator and was appointed as pastor of the parish in July 2020.

Fr. Matt looks forward to building a vibrant community at St. James that will shine Christ's light throughout Redondo Beach and the surrounding areas.

Topic: Commission of a Mission

"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations..."

Jesus' commissioning of the disciples in Matthew's account launched a broad, actionable, and enduring Catholic mission.

Q: After the events of Easter, what could we say about our particular spiritual mission now?

A: Mission Statements in our time are ubiquitous and range widely in their level of effectiveness. Some entities have mission statements that are duly posted but never really implemented. On the other hand, one school district features a clear mission statement that sets a goal of increasing student achievement. That statement is not permitted to merely be posted and to languish, but is purposefully carried out, as exemplified by a middle school in that district which viewed the many instructional decisions in light of their mission objective by asking, "How will this particular action increase student achievement?" Always, the Mission.

Here at St. James, the glorious events of Eastertide, and this point in our liturgical calendar, provide an ethos or spirit whereby rededication to our Church's mission statement seems like something that our "pilgrim Church on Earth" would do. Our St. James Parish Mission Statement:

Gospel Meditation— Father John Muir

Recently I watched a bunch of YouTube videos on how to optimize willpower in the face of weakness.

The message was: do not accept your weakness. Crush it. Dominate it. In one video, however, at the end of a rant by a willpower coach, the muscular stoic admitted, "You'll never actually get what you want, no matter how hard you try." Amazingly, he admitted that willpower alone is not sufficient for us weak-willed humans.

What does God want us to do with our weaknesses, if crushing them with willpower won't work? For example, what should I do with my tendency to arrogance and self-isolation? Or my procrastination? Or my intellectual and physical limitations? Or my selfishness?

The counter-intuitive answer is clear in this week's words from St Paul.

"I will rather boast most gladly of my weaknesses in order that the power of Christ may dwell in me (2 Cor. 12:9)."

Boast of our weaknesses? Paul isn't promoting weak-mindedness or laziness. Rather, he perceives that Jesus loves us not despite our weaknesses but because of them. Boasting of our weakness means claiming human will is not all we have. It means turning to God whenever we feel weak, which—let's face it—is almost all the time. When we do, we learn to love our weaknesses, because it's there that we meet the strength of Christ. This week, I challenge us to find ways to boast not in willpower but in weakness.


