

#### **Pastor's Letter**

Hello beautiful children of God!

The Feast of St James falls on July 25<sup>th</sup>, but since St. James is our Patron Saint, the Church allows parishes to move their Patronal Feast to Sunday. In the Church's wisdom, she believes that it is important to honor our Patron Saints as they encourage a deeper devotion to our Lord through the example of the life of the saint. We know that James was one of the first Apostles called by Jesus along with his brother John (Mt. 4:21-22) and that their evangelical zeal resulted in the nickname "sons of thunder." St James' relics reside at the end of Camino de Santiago, a 500-mile pilgrimage which ends in northwest Spain. But the story of St James offers Christians so much more to contemplate.

We witness a deep, abiding trust in the Lord from our dear friend St James. The Gospels of Matthew and Mark tell us that, upon Jesus' call to discipleship, James immediately drops his fishing net, leaves his father, and follows Jesus (Mk 1:19-20). Later on in the journey, the brothers asked Jesus if they can sit in the seats of power in his kingdom. Jesus responded by asking if they can "drink from the cup that I will drink?" They assured him that they can indeed drink from the cup, which they do with their martyrdom. In both instances, we witness James respond with great courage, not knowing where the journey may lead, because he acknowledges Jesus to be worthy of his trust.

As we celebrate the feast of our Patron Saint, St James, his profound faith in Jesus invites us to our own prayerful response to the call of discipleship. Jesus, I trust in you.



#### Catholic Q & A

J.P. Alegria

Q: What did we discuss at the 10am Mass last Sunday?

A: Recently we walked together in faith across the centuries on a Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Pastor Matt, in just his second Homily here at St. James presented Sunday's Readings, guiding us across time and place to ancient internecine wars, embedded prejudices, and the roiling challenges of a people with searching hearts who were seeking spiritual and practical guidance.

Amid his discussion of prophets, shepherds, and dressers of sycamores, Father gave a bottom- line rationale of faith, Church, and Scripture, Father presented what could be seen as a real-time, practical Catholic Mission Statement; including some of the immediately practical, essential elements of faith - all accessible without advanced degrees in theology.

Pope Francis, speaking in distilled tones on the mission of the Church: "We must proclaim the Gospel of Christ...we trust in the message of Jesus...when we share it with the world, it will flourish."

St. Jerome adds his familiar, clarified, bottom-line view on a foundational point of faith:


"Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ!"

The United States Conference Of Catholic Bishops in defining its role: "...promotes the greater good which the Church offers humankind,,,the universal law of the Church..."

The Catechism of the Catholic Church, in Paragraph #150: "Faith is first of all a personal adherence to God." As we listen and worship in an ecclesial setting or in our daily personal internalizing of faith, may we, in a true examination of conscience, again with genuine searching hearts, echo Psalm 51, which our Choir puts to beautiful music, placing us in a posture of faith:

"A clean heart create, for me, God; renew within me a steadfast spirit." Now, let's continue, as The Holy Father says, to "share it with the world."

The world is filled with people whose basic needs aren't met, whether for clean water, nutrition, safety, education, meaningful work, stable family life, basic medical resources, religious freedom, and the right to life.

So how can we possibly believe what Psalm 145 says to us this week, "The hand of the Lord feeds us, he answers all our needs"?

Does he?

What about the countless poor?

Can't we identify at least a few unmet needs in our own lives right now?

Is the Bible promoting wishful thinking and laziness in helping others?

No. The psalm flows from Israel's experience of God's relentless fidelity again and again —especially in the Passover from Egypt. This divine providence is recalled when Jesus feeds the needy multitudes in the Gospel of John. Passover arrives once again, and the people are hungry like the ancient Israelites on the wilderness journey. What is new is that in Jesus God not only provides for their needs, but He learns what it's like to have those human needs. He shares them too. He feeds them bread and fish; and even more, He hungers to provide them, and us, much more than just that kind of perishable food.

Our deepest need is for God. Like the multiplied bread, all earthly provisions ultimately fail, for we all finally die.

Of course, our obligation to meet the needs of the poor is basic. But Christ promises to feed us with the one bread that never fails: **God Himself**. He is humanity's eternal food. If we eat this bread, we taste the faithfulness of God who answers all our needs, even when every earthly thing fails.






