Saints: See Holiness

Walking along the strand, enjoying the vistas across the bay, you may recall some basic geography:

A bay is a body of water that is partially surrounded by land and connected to a larger body of water, like a lake or an ocean. We've been instructed that bays can be formed by plate tectonics, ocean overflow, erosion, and so on. But beyond physical geography there is more within those vistas which we may consider as followers of Christ.

Q: We live in the South Bay, the southern region of Santa Monica Bay. Who was Santa Monica?

A: St. Monica lived in the fourth century and was the mother of St. Augustine. She lived a difficult life with a problematic marriage and a wayward son which prompted many prayers and many tears.

Here in southern California in 1875 when what would become the city of Santa Monica was laid out, its name was said to be a derivation from a Catholic Mission named after St. Monica, as well as from a local spring in the area called:

Las Lagrimas de Santa Monica: "The Tears of St. Monica."

Franciscan Father Juan Crespi is part of this lore as part of Portola's Expedition, naming the area after Saint Monica. Pope Francis paid tribute to St. Monica:

"How many tears did that holy woman shed for her son's conversion! Do not lose hope in God's grace."

We venerate respect and revere those holy men and women whom we call on to pray for us. *The Catechism* says:

"...the saints contemplate God, praise Him and constantly care for those whom they have left on earth. Their intercession is their most exalted service to God's plan."

The Catechism Index reads - Saints: See Holiness.

Author Matthew Kelly says that each of us, as the best version of ourselves, can achieve holiness. Alban Butler's *Lives of the Saints* provides a litany of those who overcame countless challenges amid amazing processes of holiness. Pope Benedict XVI said that holiness is the common destiny of all called to be children of God, and that saints are sinners who persevered in the love and grace of Jesus; models of life and friends to us as bearers of light.

As we look across the waters of a bay we call home, and within all aspects of our days, may we contemplate the lives of the saints, who are exemplars of a love that offers the many possibilities of a dynamic, living faith.

Gospel Meditation — Father John Muir

As a young pastor years ago, I met with a middle-aged couple who had been divorced and civilly remarried.

They were frustrated that an annulment had to precede a Church marriage. Sympathizing with their plight, I promised to walk with them along their journey.

Once as we sat in my office, the man said to me, "Why is the Church so difficult on marriage?" I replied, "Actually, Jesus' teaching is what's difficult." He furrowed his brow and asked what I meant.

We opened the Bible and together read today's gospel passage from Mark 10:12 in which Jesus says,

"Whoever divorces his wife and marries another, commits adultery with her..."

My two friends sat in silent astonishment. Surely Jesus understands the complexities of human life and sexual love. The words hung thick and heavy in the air.

How could the merciful Lord be so seemingly unrealistic in his expectations, especially with so much divorce and remarriage in our world? I didn't know what to say. So, we kept reading.

Next, Jesus says, "Let the children come to me." The innocence of children allows them to receive and give love, to trust unconditionally, to believe in love that endures. Most children aren't yet jaded by statistics, broken hearts, or dysfunctional relationships. Children remind us of the world to come.

The couple and I began to talk about child-like trust in Jesus and his teaching, and we continued to move forward. When it comes to the Church's demanding teaching on marriage, it's best to approach it as trusting children, whatever situations in which we find ourselves.




