A MESSAGE FROM THE ARCHDIOCESE OF LOS ANGELES

As you may be aware, California State Assembly Bill 218 (AB 218), which was passed in 2019, lifted the statute of limitations for a second time in California allowing civil claims of past sexual misconduct involving minors during a three-year window from 2020-2022. The Archdiocese of Los Angeles was named in approximately 1,900 claims involving allegations of past sexual misconduct by clergy, religious and lay women and men going back to the 1940s. None of the claims involve recent sexual misconduct.

Since 2023, as part of our commitment to survivor-victims of sexual abuse, the Archdiocese has been working to address the coordinated AB 218 civil litigation claims, entering into active mediation with representatives of the Plaintiffs' Liaison Committee to seek a path forward that would allow the Archdiocese to support survivor victims through timely and just compensation while also allowing parishes, schools and vital ministries to serve the faithful and those in need in our communities.

Counsel for the Archdiocese and the Plaintiffs' Liaison Committee have announced that they have reached an agreement in principle through mediation that would lead to the settlement of 1353 claims involving the Archdiocese in the coordinated proceedings for \$880 million.

The Administrative Office of the Archdiocese will be taking the primary financial responsibility for funding the settlement along with payments by certain religious orders and others named in the litigation. Designated contributions to parishes, schools, and to collections or campaigns such as Called to Renew, Together in Mission and the Catholic Education Foundation will not be used to fund the settlement. It is expected that initial funding of the settlement will occur in 2025.

For more than two decades, we have made significant strides as an Archdiocese to recognize and combat sexual abuse in our parishes, schools and other locations to ensure that current cases of misconduct with minors are now rare. The Archdiocese reaffirms its commitment to survivor-victims and stands resolute against abuse. Let us continue to pray for all victim-survivors of sexual abuse in our society and let us continue to work together as a community of faith to prevent abuse and keep our parishes, schools and ministries safe for all.



Worthy of the Promises

Q: Why does the Church dedicate the month of October as a special celebration of the **Rosary**?

A: The Catechism of the Catholic Church honors Marian prayer, and calls the rosary, "an epitome of the whole Gospel." You just can't help but marvel at the amazing imagery and divine power within this meditative set of Gospel-driven devotional prayers.

In a section of *The Catechism* called (fittingly), The Way of Prayer, we read: "...we are adhering with her to the plan of the Father. The prayer of the Church is sustained by the prayer of Mary and united with it in hope."

This week we read in one of Paul's letters to Timothy about God's plan. Paul refers to it as "God's plan of salvation through faith." Mary's legacy is all about following that plan at every point in her life, and the unfolding of that plan amid the decades of the Rosary.

Luke 2:19 adds emotional clarity:

"And Mary kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart."

We also reflect on these things today within our own searching hearts.

At the Annunciation an initially perplexed Mary acceded to the will of God with a servant's heart. She then makes a difficult journey to Elizabeth, sticking to God's plan. Mary endures the difficulties associated with the realities of the Nativity. The holy family, invariably virtuous and in adherence with spiritual law and God's plan, present Jesus in the Temple. After a brief, frantic separation they find him in the Temple.

The Church venerates the events of the Joyful Mysteries, Sorrowful Mysteries, Glorious Mysteries, and Luminous Mysteries. St. John Paul II called the Rosary his favorite prayer.

We can appreciate, (in October and always), the virtuous Mary and her amazing courage and fortitude in the face of incredible challenges and obstacles.

The Holy Rosary will always be a source of exemplary guidance as we make our way along the path of salvation through faith.

Gospel Meditation — Father John Muir

Near my house there is a school for the blind.

Often, I see blind people learning how to navigate the world with only a walking stick, even on a busy street with roaring traffic. I'm amazed to see how adept and carefully they get around without sight. Nevertheless, often a sadness arises in me that he or she cannot see all the beautiful colors, images, and persons filling the world around them. Those days, I find myself deeply grateful for the basic privilege of sight.

That's part of why the mystery of Jesus as the sight-giver is so moving to me. This week, it's wonderful how Bartimaeus the blind man is no longer content with his limitation and bellows out his desire for Jesus' mercy. In beautiful simplicity, he cries out to the Lord,

"Master, let me receive my sight."

Jesus quietly heals his sight. And off he goes, fully taking in the world around him. Imagine the delightful new way in which he is able to respond to the world.

Like blind Bartimaeus and the courageous people in my neighborhood, we may be able to get around reasonably well in our daily lives.

But we are blind to the gestures of heroic love of people close to us. We can't see the desperate need of the hungry, thirsty, imprisoned, exploited, endangered, and so on, in our midst.

We can't see Jesus drawing near to us in so many ways, but he is.

This Sunday let's cry out to him: Lord have mercy on me! I want to see!

And little by little — or perhaps in a flash — we'll see once again, or perhaps for the first time.


