1. HEAR

Optional activity for the whole family: **Blessing of the Advent Wreath**

Follow these instructions and involve the children, youth and adults in the ritual.

Leader: The second candle of Advent is the Candle of Hope. It is sometimes called the Bethlehem Candle to remind us of the place in which preparations were made to receive and cradle the Christ child. Hope is a gift that we must be prepared for. God gives us the gift of hope when we turn to him in faith. (Ask someone from the fam*ily to light the 1st and 2nd candles in the Advent wreath.*)

All: Loving God, we thank you for the hope you give us through Jesus. Help us prepare our hearts to receive Him. Bless our worship. Guide us in all that we say and do. We ask it in the name of the one born in Bethlehem, Iesus our Lord. Amen.

(The two candles are allowed to burn during the evening meals of the second week.)

3. TALK

Have a conversation as a household/family. If you live by yourself consider hosting a virtual gathering or call someone to have a conversation.


