1. HEAR

2. PRAY

Write these on a piece of paper.

After completing the list, prayerfully read it and thank God for the abundant blessings you have received.

Ask Jesus how he wants you to share these abundant blessings and who he wants you to share them with.

What do you hear Jesus saying to you?

3. TALK

In today's Gospel reading, Mary saw the need during the wedding and recognized that the servers could help if they followed what Jesus asked them to do. God gives us abundant gifts in our lives that we are meant to share with others.



Select one of the gifts from the list you created and share with your family how Jesus is asking you to use that gift to bless others.

Let the others in your family share their own insights about how you can share that gift with and for others.
