Pastor's Letter

Hello Beautiful Children of God!

The 6th Sunday in Ordinary Time (cycle C) provides Luke's version of the Beatitudes. The Beatitudes, translated "**sacred blessedness**," are God's pathway to happiness. Our journey to happiness can only be found in the Lord and discovered through a life of humility and sacrifice.

In early November, we elected representatives across the nation to govern the nation on our behalf. This month, celebrities across many genres will be recognized for their work in the film and music industries. The Philadelphia Eagles lifted the Lombardi Trophy as champions of the NFL last weekend. The award, by the way, is named after famed football coach **Vince Lombardi, a devout Catholic and daily communicant**. In the eyes of the world, these select few have reached the pinnacle of their profession and they should be applauded for their hard work and skill. However, the Beatitudes remind us that all the fame, wealth, and accolades will not bring happiness.

Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life? Matthew 16:24-26a

Happiness can only be found in relationship with God through a life of humility and sacrifice. The purpose of our faith is to turn our hearts and minds to God every day so that He may fill us with the profound joy that only He can provide. We Walk By Faith

In a recent Homily, Deacon Bob animated the scripture readings by challenging parishioners to be "a Simeon," and to be "an Anna." The Deacon's teaching prompts reflection about those figures in Luke's Gospel, one a devout man awaiting "the consolation of Israel," the other a holy prophetess who fasted and prayed unceasingly "for the redemption of Israel."

Q: Our patron, St. James said,

"Be ye doers of the Word, and not hearers only."

After hearing the Word, and as part of our own consolation and redemption, what active and enduring spiritual action is foremost here?

A: Faith. A constancy of faith as exemplified by Simeon and Anna is embedded throughout our Catholic beliefs. At Mass, after the Consecration, the Priest intones,

"The mystery of faith!"

That mystery of faith we can also profess every Monday and Saturday among the decades of the Rosary in the Joyful Mysteries which include the faithful Simeon and Anna at the presentation of the Lord in the temple.

Holy Scripture epitomizes the Holy Spirit's action in its teachings about faith. St. Mark relates the parable of the little girl restored to life and a woman healed, with the coda in these events the words and actions of Jesus:

"Fear not, only believe."

"Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole, go in peace..."

Faith. *The Catechism* calls it a *gift*... "the theological virtue by which we believe in God and believe all that he has said and revealed to us..."

St. Pope John Paul II spoke about the kind of faith that goes to the heart and the works of an Anna and a Simeon:

"Faith accompanied by good works is contagious and spreads light, for it makes visible and communicates God's love."

Sacramental Confession

No sin is new to him.

No wrongdoing too great.

Come to Confession and experience the cleansing power of God's love.

I craved four things as a teenager: success in sports, food, fun and the attention of popular people. However, I noticed that as I acquired them, I was more unsatisfied than before. So, I'd strive even more energetically, achieve more, and the sense of emptiness was greater still. These four things started to feel like burdens or even curses. Soon after, I encountered Christ in my high school youth group. Experiencing his love was totally different than anything those four things previously produced. It produced a lasting happiness.

Jesus utters a kind of four-fold curse in this week's Gospel of Saint Luke's "woes":

"Woe to you who are rich...who are filled now...who laugh now...who are well-spoken of" (cf. Luke 6:24-26).

How marvelous that these correspond perfectly to the four things that obsessed my teenage soul: riches, food, laughter and good reputation. The "woes" the Lord speaks are warnings: when those things are the *purpose* of your life, you'll be miserable. He is saying, **"You'll be happy, or blessed, in the measure that these things do not determine the shape of our lives, and the kingdom of God does."**

To some degree, we're all spiritual teenagers, addicted to one or more of those four "woes."

How splendid that the Lord wants his to bless us — that is, to satisfy us, make us laugh with joy, and in the kingdom of God, offer us what will truly satisfy us.

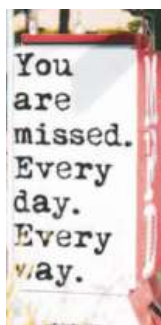
But first let's admit what is causing our "woes."

In all of the other sacraments, Jesus gives us his grace, says St. Thomas Aquinas, whereas in the Eucharist, the "sacrament of sacraments," he gives us his whole self, his divinity and his humanity. **Call us if you are unable to attend so an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist can bring Him to you. We're not complete without you!**

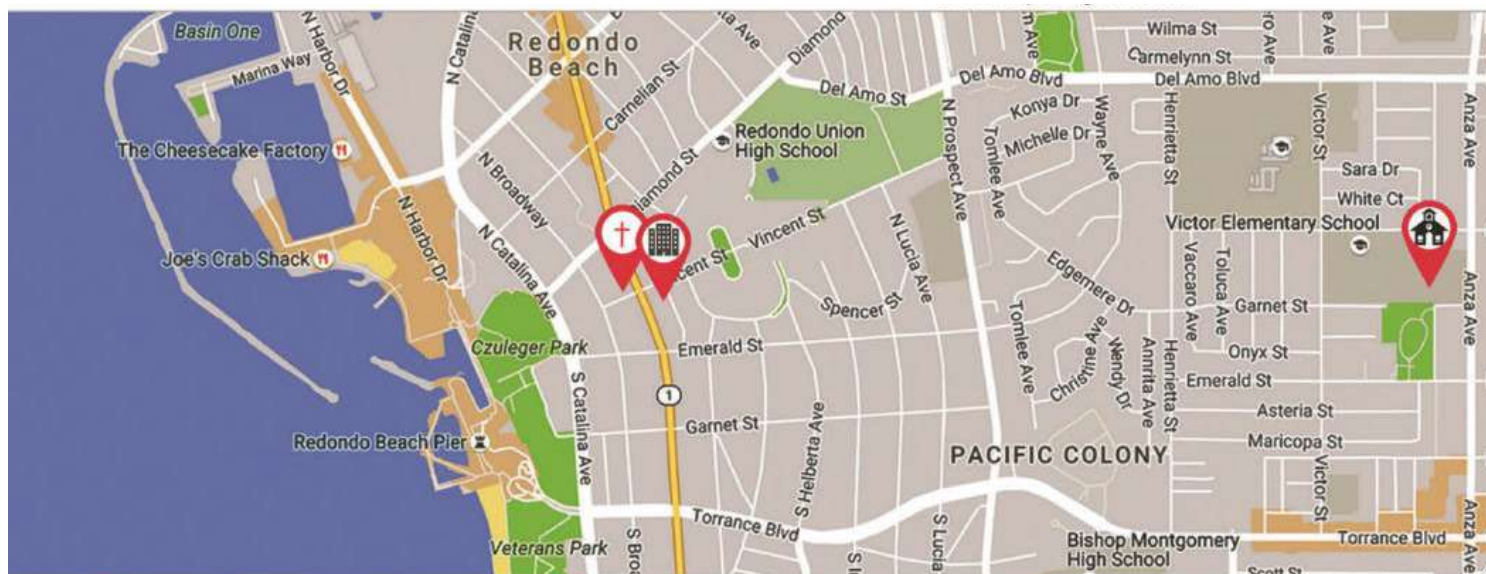
